THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE CHECKLIST

Medication(s)

Prepare a list of all your current prescribed, over-the-counter, vitamins and herbal medications to bring to the hospital on the day of your procedure.

- Even if you have reviewed this information with your surgeon's office or the Pre-Anesthesia team, a pre-op nurse or clinician <u>must</u> confirm your medications and allergies <u>on the day of your procedure</u> to ensure nothing has changed. Having a well-prepared list will assist in a smooth day of the surgery process.
- The list should include:
 - 1. Name(s), Dosage(s), Frequency (e.g., 2x day, daily, weekly, etc.), Last time taken (each medication)
- Please include any medication(s) that have caused you to have an allergic reaction and what that reaction is.
- On the morning of your procedure, you will take the medication(s) according to the instructions provided by your surgeon and/or the Pre-Anesthesia team.

Shower/Bathing

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	If the patient was instructed to complete pre-op bathing/shower or wipes, please follow the pre-op bathing instructions
	per the surgeon's office.
	 Depending on the patient's type of procedure, bathing instructions <u>may</u> include Hibiclens. If so, please follow the
	surgeon's instructions. If you have questions, please contact the surgeon's office directly.
	Do not shave your surgical area before your procedure. It will be done by the hospital staff.

Transportation

- Arrange to have a responsible adult (at least 18 years of age) drive or accompany you home after your procedure (if using public transportation).
 - We recommend that the person stay with you for 24 to 48 hours after the procedure.
 - If you are unaccompanied on the day of the procedure, your procedure will be rescheduled or canceled.

Dependent Care

☐ Plan for someone to care for all dependents (children and adults) during your surgical stay.

Other Important Information

Leave valuables, large amounts of cash, credit cards, and jewelry at home or with a friend for safekeeping.

• The hospital is not responsible for lost/stolen items.

Have storage cases for contacts, glasses, dentures, etc., during your procedure.

Remove all makeup, fingernail polish, piercings/jewelry, etc. from your body

Procedure times are subject to change. You <u>may</u> receive a phone call from hospital staff or your surgeon's office the evening before informing you of your new procedure time. Please contact your surgeon's office if you have ANY questions about your surgical date or time.
