THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE CHECKLIST

Medication(s)	
	Take your medication(s) according to the instructions provided by your surgeon and/or Pre-Anesthesia.
	Confirm that you have a list of all your current prescribed, over-the-counter, vitamins, and herbal medications to bring to the hospital.
	 Even if you have reviewed this information with your surgeon's office or the Pre-Anesthesia team, a pre-op nurse or clinician <u>must</u> confirm your medications and allergies <u>on the day of your procedure</u> to ensure nothing has changed. Having a well-prepared list will assist in a smooth day of the surgery process. The list should include:
	1. Name(s), Dosage(s), Frequency (e.g., 2x day, daily, weekly, etc.), Last time taken (each medication)
	 Please include any medication(s) that have caused you to have an allergic reaction and what that reaction is.
	 Do not bring any medications to the hospital unless instructed by your surgeon's office or the Pre-Anesthesia team. The hospital will provide medication(s) as needed.
Shower or bathing	
	Shower/bathe the morning of your procedure following the pre-op bathing instructions/recommendations per your surgeon's office.
	■ Depending on the patient's type of procedure, your bathing instructions <u>may</u> include Hibiclens. If so, please follow your surgeon's instructions. If you have questions, please contact <u>your surgeon's office directly</u> .
	Do not shave your surgical area before your procedure. It will be done by the hospital staff.
	Brush your teeth.
	Do not wear makeup, jewelry, perfumes, or lotions. You may use a little deodorant.
	Wear clean, loose-fitting clothes and low-heeled shoes.
	Ensure all fingernail polish and all body piercings have been removed.
Transportation	
	Have a responsible adult (at least 18 years of age) drive or accompany you home (if using public transportation).
	• If you receive anesthesia, we recommend that the person stay with you for 24 - 48 hours after the procedure.
	 If you are unaccompanied on the day of the procedure, your procedure will be rescheduled or canceled.
	Bring money for parking payment.
Re	gistration
	Bring your photo identification (ID), insurance card, and money to pay your copayment.
Otl	her Important Information
	Do <u>not</u> smoke before/on the day of your procedure.
	Leave valuables, large amounts of cash, credit cards, and jewelry at home or with a friend for safekeeping.
	 The hospital is not responsible for lost/stolen items.
	Have storage cases for contacts, glasses, dentures, hearing aids, etc., during your procedure.
	If applicable, bring your cane and/or inhaler(s)
