**POLICY:**

For all clinical areas, the Department of Anesthesia personnel will follow the evacuation plan for that particular patient area in which they are providing anesthesia services. If not a patient care location, a separate procedure will be developed for administrative staff.

**PROCEDURE:**Clinical Areas:

The anesthesia team member responsible for evacuation from the various clinical areas is the senior member of the team:

<u>Location</u>	<u>Responsible Anesthesia Personnel</u>	<u>Attachment</u>
Main OR	Anesthesiologist-in-Charge	A
Same Day Surgery	Anesthesiologist-in-Charge	B
Acute Pain Service	Pain Attending Physician	C
Labor and Delivery	OB Anesthesiologist	D

Each of these established anesthetizing locations have developed an evacuation plan that has been reviewed by the Department of Anesthesia.

Non Clinical/Administrative Area:

The Department of Anesthesia office, call rooms and library are located on the Lower Level of the CCC building. This is not a patient care area. The Administrator or senior member of the staff will notify all staff present in the affected area. Attachment E details the Evacuation plan.
