




- a. Enter your assigned user name (will be sent to you prior to go live)





1. Ignore Health Profile Tab at top in middle
2. Investigate the Template tab – This tab allows providers to preselect answers to questions. I.e. if you are in GI select GI, if in cardiac select cardiac template
3. Indicate if any adverse Event occurred – if yes mark in the event area below (area with + sign)
4. Indicate if Case was an emergency
5. Answer the MIPS questions for which there are 10
6. Enter metric for event that occurred (Please ignore Pain section)
7. Once completed press the Submit button in Rt lower corner
